NAMI Family Programs Educator Requirements:

- Must be a member of NAMI. **\$60 per year for a Household membership** that includes all members of a household living at the same address. **\$40 per year for a Regular membership** which is an individual membership. **\$5 per year for an Open Door membership** for an individual member with limited financial resources
- Be at a point in their life where they are familiar and comfortable with the emotional issues families face and can self-disclose about their own feelings regarding their life situation.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Candidates must be referred by their affiliate education coordinator, Family to Family teacher or their local NAMI board member.
